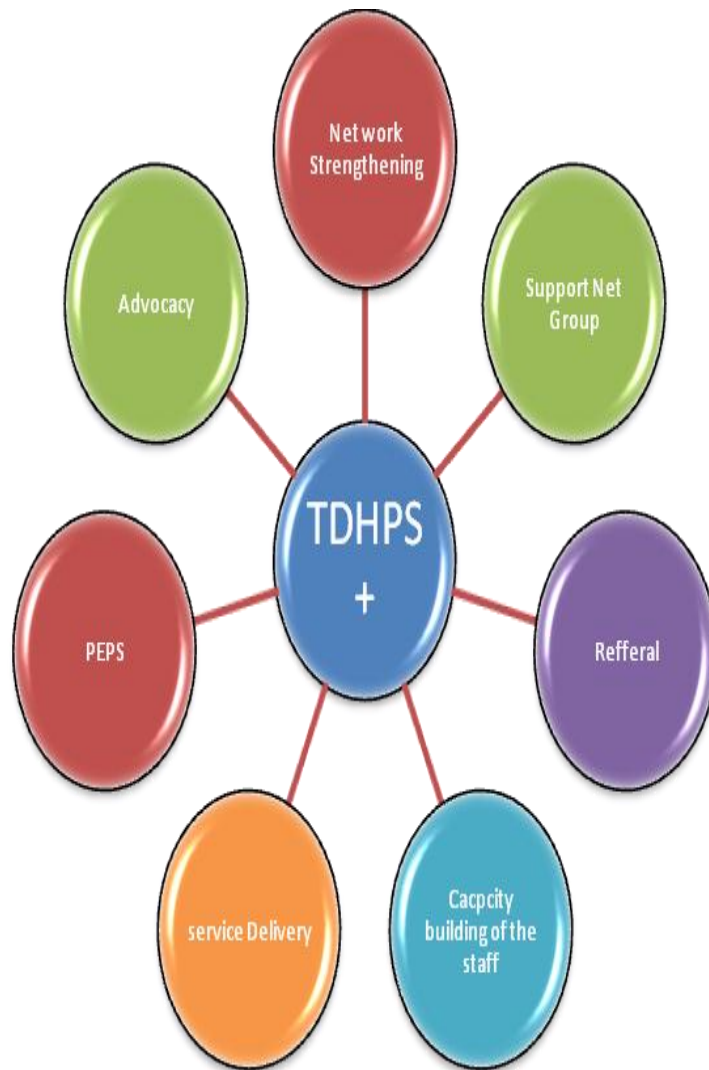

- We do home visit for PLHA's home for their permission and give treatment adherence for them

➤ HIV & TB Co-Infection

- We motivate the people to attend the training for HIV & TB Co-infection. They learned more

➤ Funeral Services

- If the Patient has no body for his help we support and if he death we take in charge for Funeral Services.

TALUK SUPPORT NET MEETING

During this year we conducted 12 meeting for these support net group, through these meetings;

- 25 HIV peoples were identified with help of SNM/PEPS.
- Defaults clients were identified and now they are going for regular treatment.
- O I Clients were referred for the treatment by SNM/PEPS.
- Internal loans were distributed for support net group members.
- TDHPS+ President and Support net group member Mrs.Elamathi distributed 10kg rice to 10 childrens' (total 100kg)
- Support net group said that “ after joining to this group we forget about our disease and we actively participating in the group meeting with joy, now a days we are going to banks also”

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SENSITIZATION MEETING

During this year Nine sensitization meetings were conducted. Five meetings were conducted at ICTC centre and four meetings were at ICDS centre. Through these meeting;

- Helping mind and good cooperation were raised among VHS, ANM, ICTC Counsellore, ICTC lab Technicians, Nurse, NGOs and Anganvadi workers.
- Now Identifying new clients were easy.
- In Arani hospital they were not done siserians delivery for the HIV +ve pregnancy, we asked reason to this hospital and they said that they do not have glouses, and we raised this issue to DPM in District coordination meeting and now they supplying enough of glouses and now this hospital doing siserians delivery to HIV +ve pregnancies.
- In ICDS meeting we told them to provide more nutrition food to the HIV +ve family children, now they are providing more nutrition food to these children and also referring such children to TDHPS+.

District Coordination Meeting

Three district coordination meetings were conducted during this year. TANSAC DPM, District Supervisor, ART medical Officer, DDHS Office, ICDS DPM, CCC, DIG Office, Grace Hospital , Rangammal Hospital, REACH Organisation, DIC, Mobile ICTC Counsellor, TNAHDCO bank, NGOs Magalir thittam, Vazhnthu Kaattuvom and TNVHA representative were attended these meetings.

- One of our Support net group member got swipper work at ART centre.
- Two members got part time job in TNVHA project.
- People who referred by us getting good treatment from CCC.
- Four people got tailoring training from Magalir Thittam in this two members were our support Net group.
- Two children were admitted in TDH children home.

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SOCIAL WELFARE SCHEMES

VAZHNTU KATTUVOM THITTAM

- 180 people were participated in self employment camps which conducted by Vazhntu Kaattuvom thittam at Tiruvannamalai, Chengam, Pudhupalayam and Jamnamarathur block. Through these camp 120 people got self employment loan Rs. 20000/- with 30% of subsidy.

MAGALIR THITTAM

- Through MAGALIR THITTAM 6 people got Rs.15000/- loan with 50% subsidy.

TAHDCO Loan

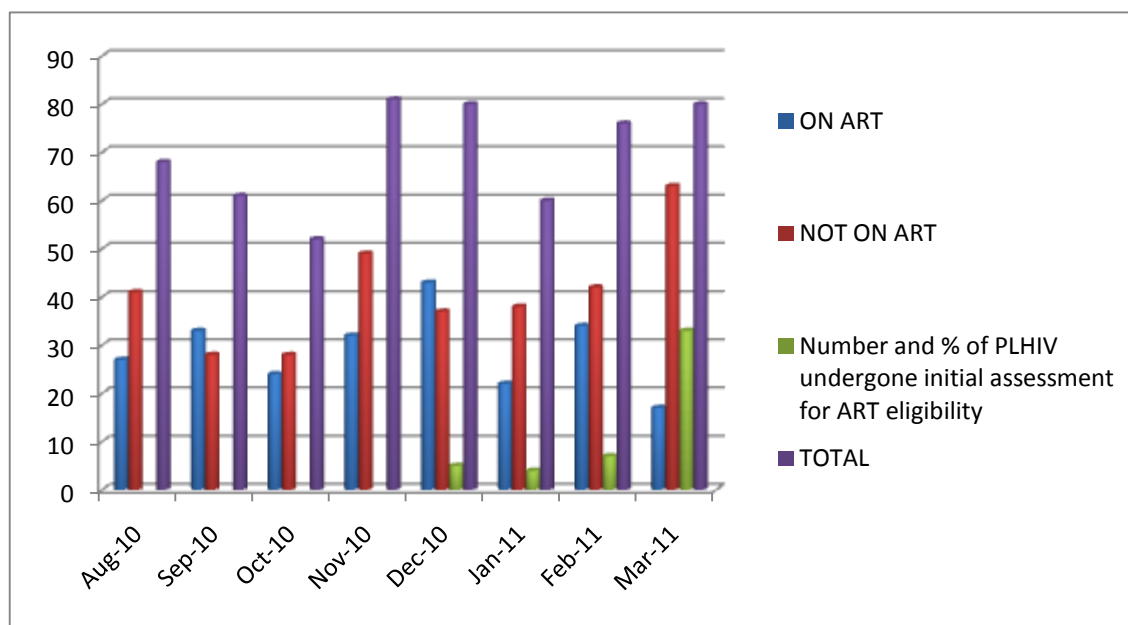
